Supplement to Application for Homestead Exemption and Declaration of





Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Florida Constitution provides that a property owner with legal or equitable title may qualify for homestead exemption if the property is the permanent residence of a legal or natural dependant of the owner.

Once the homestead exemption is granted, it becomes subject to the automatic renewal provisions of State law. However, if you qualify for homestead exemption solely because your natural or legal dependant(s) permanently reside on the property, the exemption may be removed when your dependant(s) lose their dependent status (e.g. when they reach the age of 18) or no longer reside on the property. Therefore, you must notify the Property Appraiser's Office whenever any of the following changes occurs: use or ownership of the property; legal status of the owner or legal/natural dependant(s); change of residence of the legal/natural dependant(s) or other relevant factors. (Ref. 196.031, Florida Statutes).
